- What is NCTUE the acronym for?

Answer: National Consumer Telecommunications and Utilities Exchange

- Many phone carriers and some utility and cable companies rely on NCTUE for credit checks.
- It is a consumer reporting agency founded by AT&T in 1997 and is operated by Equifax.

- What is ChexSystems?

Answer: A credit reporting agency used by thousands of banks to verify customers and they are permitted to sell your name to potential creditors so you can receive prescreened offers unless you opt- out. To opt-out for five years, call 1-877-678-6885
